Thanks for your email and I note your objections to the HCC school scheme. Apologies for the delay in getting back to you.

For clarity we have not started the process of school land transfer to HCC. It is my understanding that HCC will only take a transfer of the school site once it has been serviced in accordance with the s.106.

It also strikes us from reading your objection, the detail that you are seeking in terms of how the school development interfaces with the wider development servicing, particularly drainage, will be addressed at the point applications are made for the school site servicing works by the developer.

It was great to meet you both yesterday.

During our meeting we mentioned our objective to try and get the Design Code and Phase 1 RM Application submitted and approved before the end of 2019. Hopefully, like us, you are keen to see this site deliver new homes after such a long lead in. A decision this year will provide an opportunity to complete at least a few homes in 2020.

You mentioned in the meeting that you wished to undertake design team meetings with us to evolve both the Design Code and the first RM and that the Design Code document would need to be approved by the Planning Committee before the RM application could be subsequently heard.
